


HOW TO PREFERENCE YOUR OFFERS (YOUNG PEOPLE)

KentChoices is an online platform managed by The Education People on behalf of Kent County Council, which allows young people to search, apply and receive offers of sixth form and college places at Kent schools and colleges.

Young people each year are asked to set their offers/applications in order of preference (i.e. 1st, 2nd, 3rd choices and so on). Young people don't need to have three, but they should at least have a backup plan.

To set your preferencing, it is easy to do, by following the steps below.


Step 1 – Sign into [KentChoices](#)




Step 2 – Go to My Applications




Step 3 – Accept or Reject



Step 4 – Put offers in Order



Step 5 – Use the arrows to make your 1st, 2nd, 3rd choice etc, click Save and Update to finish
